

The monarch butterfly is sometimes called the "milkweed butterfly" because its larvae eat a plant called "Milkweed." The toxins from milkweed make the butterfly poisonous, and bigger animals won't eat them.




They lay their eggs on milkweed leaves and the eggs hatch, in 3 to 12 days.









The caterpillar stays in the cocoon and in two weeks it turns into a butterfly. When it first comes out of the cocoon, it fills its wings with blood and then waits until they stiffen and dry before it flies away.

Each fall, monarch butterflies fly south to Mexico so they can be warm. In the spring, they fly north again to the United States and Canada.
