INSTRUCTIONS:

1. PRINT THE PAGES IN THE PACK. I found it was helpful to print the paper dolls on cardstock. You can choose to print the scenes on regular paper if you're going to use a folder or cardboard for the background scenes.

2. HAVE CHILD COLOR THE PAPER DOLLS AND ACCESSORIES.

3. LAMINATE FOR DURABILITY. This is optional, but will definitely help with the continued use with velcro pieces.

4. CUT OUT PAPER DOLLS AND ACCESSORIES.

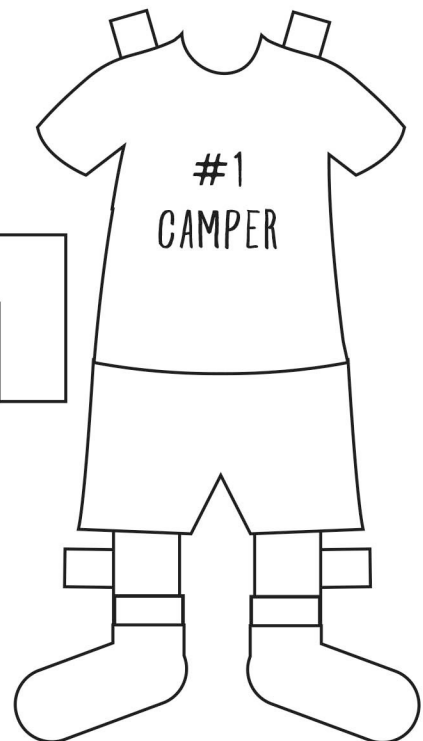
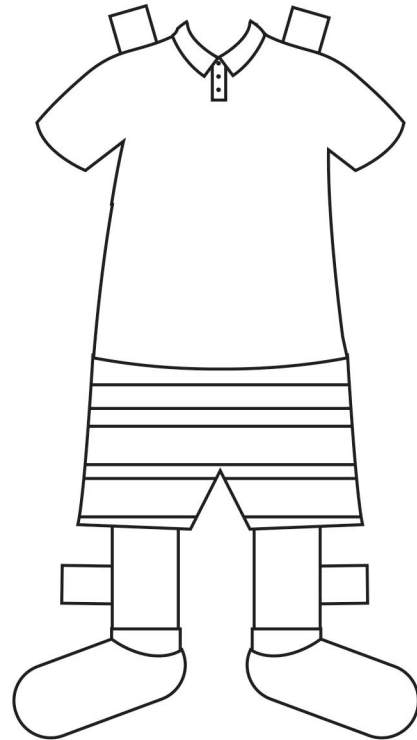
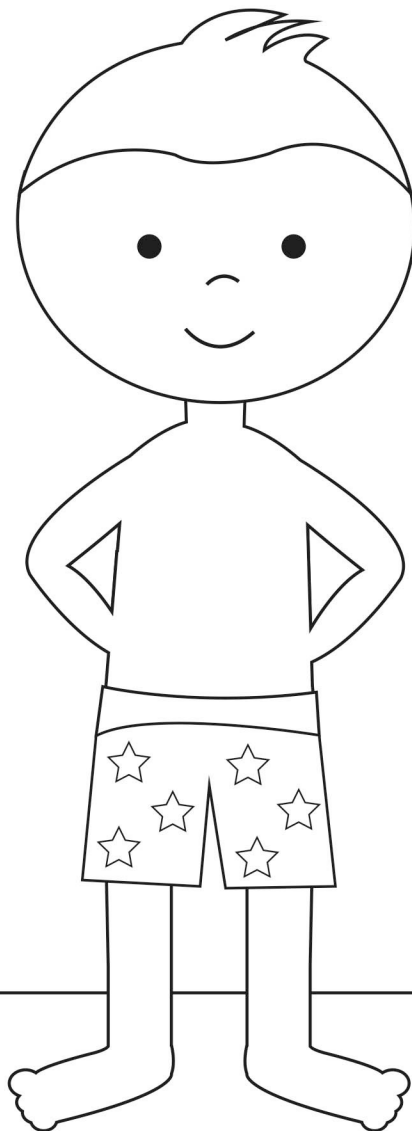
5. ATTACH VELCRO PIECES TO BACKS OF ACCESSORIES AND TO THE BACKGROUND SCENES.

6. GLUE THE BACKGROUND SCENES TO FOLDER. I used a regular file folder, but other items could work such as a recycled box or a pocket folder. I found spray glue (Super 77 or Elmer's) was the best for gluing laminated pages.

7. HAVE FUN! Please remember this set is for personal use only! It may not be resold or changed.

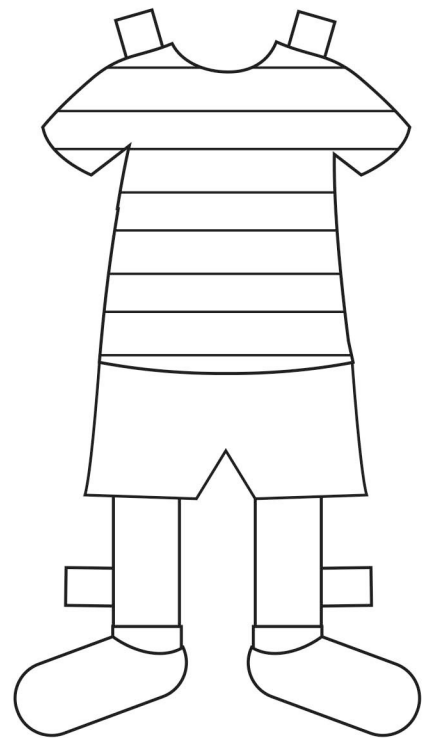
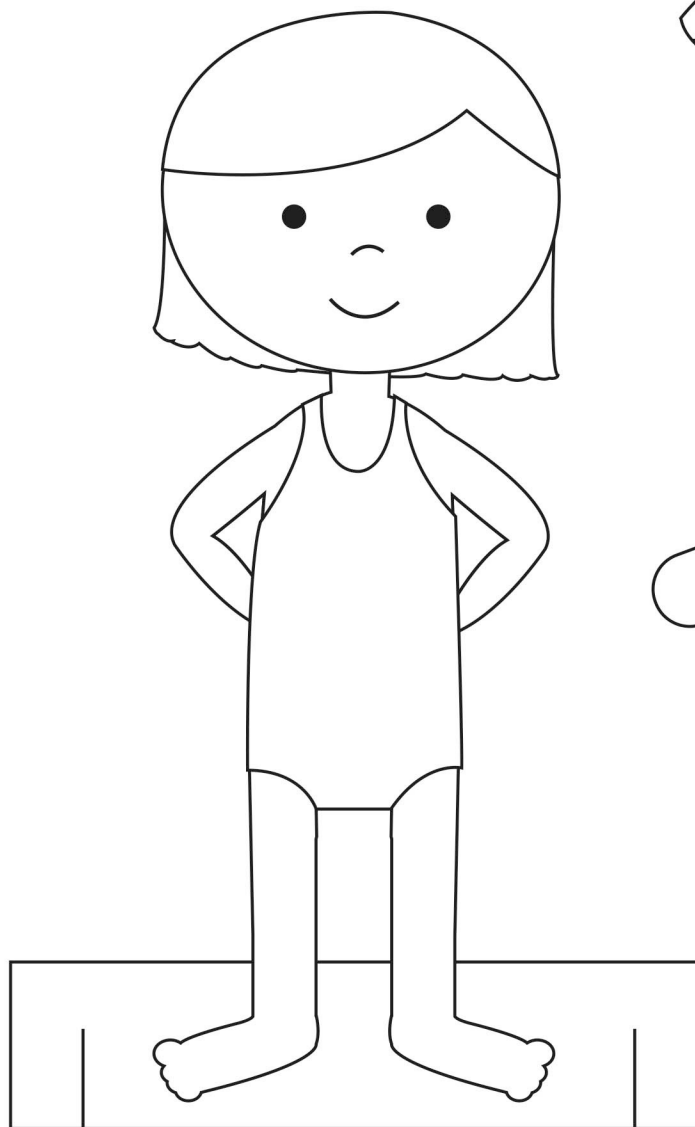
